Capacity is specific to the medical decision at hand, decision made by a physician



Capacity to Consent

Ability to **communicate**

Ability to **understand** the proposed treatment and alternative interventions

Ability to appreciate the consequences of accepting or declining the suggested treatment

Ability to **explain the rationale** for their choice
